

If you are not using our transfer service this information will help you to get to your accommodation.

If you are using a taxi

- We recommend you **go directly** to your accommodation.

If you are using public transport (bus or train)

- We recommend you **come to Glasgow city centre** first and then take a train or bus to your accommodation.

When you are in Glasgow city centre please look at the information about your accommodation. This will tell you which bus or train to use and where you get it from.

Please note that the following information and fares are provided for your information only and prices and services are subject to change by the transport providers.

Buses in Glasgow

Glasgow has one bus station: **Buchanan bus station**

Buses from Glasgow Airport, Glasgow Prestwick Airport and Edinburgh Airport go here.

Trains in Glasgow

Glasgow has 2 main train stations- **Central Station and Queen Street Station**

- **Central Station**

Direct trains from Glasgow Prestwick Airport go here.

- **Queen Street**

Trains from Edinburgh go here (first you will need to catch a bus from Edinburgh Airport to Edinburgh Haymarket or Edinburgh Waverley train station and get the train to Glasgow Queen Street).

From Glasgow airport

There are two buses you can take:

- **First 500 Glasgow Shuttle service to Glasgow City Centre**

Take a bus to Glasgow Buchan Bus Street station

1 journey ticket: £6.00

2 journey ticket (can be used anytime) £8.50

- **Service 747 AirLink City Service TO Glasgow City Centre**

Take a bus to Glasgow Buchan Bus Street station.

1 journey ticket: £3.90

2 Journey adult ticket: £3.95. Valid on all First services including 747 AirLink

2 journey plus ticket: £5 plus, use your £5 return ticket (First Day Plus) for unlimited travel, network-wide until 1am* on the day after purchase and your return journey leg to the airport within two weeks

From Glasgow Prestwick airport

Glasgow Prestwick airport has its own train station.

Direct trains from the airport to Glasgow Central train station go during the following times:

- 0548 - 2308 Monday - Saturday (every 30 minutes)
- 0850 - 2307 Sunday (every hour)

1 journey ticket (full price): £7.60

If you show your flight confirmation to the ticket seller you will get a 50% discount on the standard fare.

Early morning and late flight arrivals can use the **X99/X100 airport express bus service at 23.59** which takes you to Buchanan Bus Street station in Glasgow.

1 journey ticket £8.00

From Edinburgh Airport

We recommend you take the train from Edinburgh to Glasgow Queen Street.

You can get to the Edinburgh train station by taxi or by bus.

The bus **Airlink 100** and **N22** (night bus) service calls at Waverley train station and Haymarket train station.

The journey time is 25 to 30 minutes in normal traffic.

Airlink 100 is every 10 minutes (early services every 20 minutes).

1 journey ticket: £4.00

N22 This service runs from the airport between 00:47 and 04:13, seven nights a week, every 30 minutes.

£3 per ticket (unlimited travel for one night)

Trains to Glasgow Queen Street station go from Edinburgh Waverly and Edinburgh Haymarket train station.

The train takes about 1 hour

1 journey ticket: £13.20

Once you are in Glasgow, please look at the information about your accommodation. This will tell you how to go from Glasgow School of English to your accommodation.
